OUR PROGRAMS

We operate primarily as a **children center and home.** We take care of vulnerable and underprivileged children from the moment they enter in our organization until the day they find a proper job and can provide for themselves as independent adults. We believe that the best way to do so is to reproduce what a family would and that is to take care of their well being, education and health.


We currently provide **schooling, shelter, clothing, medical care and psychosocial counseling for 15 orphaned children** that we consider our own. We adopt a holistic education model, which means that in addition to the academics, we also nurture the development of a child's emotions, social skills, spiritual beliefs, and community involvement.

In addition to the center, we also pursue a secondary mission and solution in order to fight the rise of underprivileged families and children in our community. We provide case by case and punctual **financial help to individual families with urgent needs**. The range of our financial support goes from 0% interest loans to simple and straightforward donations. We are also occasionally willing to donate tangible goods such as food or tools.






OUR WORK

is **14 years old** and comes from **Mbeya**, southwest of Tanzania. We met him at the Social Welfare office in Arusha . He had arrived from Mbeya the day before by bus. At the bus stand he didn't find the person who promised him a job so he went to the police station to ask for help. He left the school when he was 10 years old and since then he used to do any types of jobs in order to help his family. When he arrived at The Nuru trust children's home he could not write, read, count. We insert him in a special program for drop-out children in a government school in Usa River. **Now he can read, write and he knows the basic concept of mathematics. Next year he will attend the standard 4 national examination.** He is very motivated and happy to have the chance to study and live his youth! He says that when he will finish his studies he wants to be a social worker because he wants to help other children like him.



DOMINICK ANAEL

19 years old, is one of the oldest youth of the children's home. He arrived at the center when he was 4 years old. Last year he got the O - level (secondary school) and in since October he is attending the **Forestry Training Institute thanks a sponsorship program.** This year he worked for two months in a tented camp and he has been involved in the Children's Home activities carrying out different tasks, such as helping kids with home works, going grocery shopping, looking after the store. For Dominick this was an important year also because thanks to our family outreach program, after 15 years he could discover his roots and meet his family again!



ELIZABETH PALLANGYO


